Maria Da Graça Carvalho Member, European Parliament

Maria Da Graça Carvalho has been a member of the European Parliament (EPP group) since 2009. She sits on the ITRE-Industry, Research and Energy Committee and is Co-President of the Economic Development, Finance and Trade Committee of ACP-EU Joint Parliamentary Assembly.

She was a principal adviser of President Barroso in the areas of science, higher education, innovation, research policy, energy, environment and climate change from 2006 to 2009, and is a full professor at Technical University of Lisbon.



Daniela CoutoCo-Founder, Vice-President and
Chief Executive Officer, Cell2B

Daniela is currently CEO at Cell2B, a biotechnology start-up dedicated to the development of a new line of healthcare therapies to treat organ rejection in patients undergoing transplants. She has been awarded several research grants and entrepreneurial awards, namely the Women Entrepreneur Award 2011. Cell2B was a finalist at the European Academic Enterprise Awards 2012 and awarded the €40,000 Everis Award (ACES) 2012.

Daniela S. Couto graduated with the highest honors in Bioengineering in 2011 from Instituto Superior Técnico — Technical University of Lisbon, as part of the MIT-Portugal Program. Daniela developed her studies in technological innovation at Massachusetts Institute Technology for a total of 2 years.

Vicky Ford *Member, European Parliament*

Vicky Ford was elected as Conservative Party Member of the European Parliament for East of England in the 2009 European Parliament election. She is the UK Conservative spokesman for Industry and Research, sitting on the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy and also has seats on the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Food Safety and the Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs.

Before entering politics, Ford spent 14 years in Finance, mostly at JP Morgan, specialising in infrastructure and project financing. She studied maths and economics at Trinity College, Cambridge.



Danuta Hübner *Member, European Parliament*

Danuta Hübner has been a member of the European Parliament Delegation for Relations with the United States, and the Delegation for Relations with Switzerland, Iceland, Norway and to the EEA Joint Parliamentary Committee, and she works closely with the Baltic-Europe Intergroup, the Climate Change, Biodiversity and Sustainable Development Intergroup, the Federalist Intergroup and the URBAN Intergroup.

She is a prominent Polish economist and was instrumental in leading Poland toward membership in the European Union and the OECD. She became the first Minister for European Affairs in the Polish government, as well as the first Polish EU Commissioner. In her work as Commissioner, she was responsible for Regional Policy.



Quentin PankhurstFounder and CTO,
Endomagnetics Ltd

Quentin Pankhurst is the Director of the Institute of Biomedical Engineering at University College London. The IBME acts as a bridge between 7 medical and science/engineering faculties, and is a consortium of 150 principal investigators across 35 different centres, departments and institutes.

He is also the Director of the Davy-Faraday Research Laboratory and Wolfson Professor of Natural Philosophy – a post once held by Lord Ernest Rutherford – at the Royal Institution of Great Britain, in London.

He is a founder and CTO of Endomagnetics Ltd, a spinout company which is commercialising the SentiMag $^{\text{TM}}$, an intra-operative device for breast cancer surgery.

Since joining the European Parliament in 2011, Salvador Sedó sees his main task as promoting research and innovation on behalf of SMEs. In order to best serve this role, vice-president of SME Europe since October 2012.
